*The students of the European School are divided into three categories:

- Category I: Students whose parents are members of the staff of or seconded to a European Institution or an assimilated organization. The employer must certify that the duration of the contract lasts for a minimum period of one year. These students are exempted from school fees.
- Category II: Students whose parents are members of the staff of a company or an organization which has concluded a special agreement with the European schools and certifies that it will pay the school fees for the enrolled student.
- **Category III:** Students whose parents do not belong to categories I or II and pay the requested school fee themselves. These students can be admitted if places are available and if they fulfil other conditions as defined by the school.
